Code of Ethics

Generally, we are to be honest, fair, and trustworthy ourselves and to take care that other members of the university community are as well.

- x Avoid both conflicts of interests and the appearance of such conflicts;
- x Promptly complete Conflict of Interest Training and Certification as required for board membership;
- x Safeguard confidential information;
- x Make procurement decisions impartially and objectively;
- x Ensure, through open communication with the University's internal and state auditors, that effective internal controls are in place to safeguard the transactional integrity of our activities;
